TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PERFORMERS

As organizers, there are several rules we need to enforce in order to comply with ordinances of the City of Palo Alto. Our objective is to have an event that is fun and safe for everybody, and that will continue every year in Palo Alto. With that in mind, we would like to ask that all participants in your musical group agree to the following terms and conditions:

- You understand that you will be performing for free at Palo Alto World Music Day.
- You authorize Palo Alto World Music Day organizers to list your band name and web site address submitted by you on the pamusicday.org web site. You also accept to be briefly videotaped, and a few photos of your group to be taken during the event to help us promote future Palo Alto World Music Day events.
- You will let the organizers know ASAP if for some reason you need to cancel your participation to the event, by sending an e-mail to info@pamusicday.org
- You will promptly follow all requests related to public safety made by the event organizers, or the Palo Alto Police Department. **Public safety is critical.**
- You will not aggressively solicit donations (e.g. no passing of the hat). Opening the guitar case, or having a hat placed on the sidewalk for donations is authorized.
- You will not sell anything at the event, except if you have received a solicitor permit from the Palo Alto Police Department (free and easy to obtain as official participants of the World Music Day event (more on that later).
- You will not use power amplification, unless it is operated by a portable battery. There will be no access to electric power outlets (except in one location), and generators will not be allowed. **If you plan on using battery-operated power amplification, please let us know** so that we can get the proper authorization on your behalf.
- You will use blue tape to affix all low lying power cords between your instruments and equipment to the sidewalk, in order to eliminate tripping hazards for the public.

- You will perform at the location assigned by the organizers.
- You understand that there is no stage; this is a street performance. You will need to be self sufficient and bring all that you need for your performance (e.g. chairs) and will be responsible for your own set-up and tear-down.
- You will arrive on time and leave by the end of the assigned time period. Your assigned time period includes: set-up, performance, and tear-down time. For those on the first time period, set-up can start at 2:30 pm, 30 min before the beginning of the event. For those in the third time period, tear-down must be done by 7:45 pm, 15 min after the end of the event. Please allow for plenty of time to arrive, as parking in downtown Palo Alto might be a challenge on that day!
- You will accept to provide us with responses to a brief survey that we will send you after the event. The objective will be to provide feedback to the organizers and help them improve Palo Alto World Music Day in future years.
- You understand that the organizers need some flexibility and might have to, in some instances, change performance time or location. You also understand that your participation to the event is subject to the organizers receiving all mandatory permits and approvals from the City of Palo Alto and its Police Department.
